

How we are handling Covid-19 at the shelter...

I am reaching out to reassure and inform every one of the precautions we're taking to keep our residents, staff, volunteers, donors, and greater community safe. It is our priority to continue to serve our community in a loving, caring, and responsible manner.

Extensive steps have been taken to sanitize our facilities and we have a hand washing station at the front entrance, and exit where all of our residents and staff have been directed to enter and leave from. As recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, we are disinfecting regularly and have posted signs to remind folks on how to properly wash their hands.

We are carefully monitoring all updates and have formed an on-site response team made up of the House Manager, Case Manager and Director to handle any changing situation. We are monitoring all related news releases from our local health department; SP Police Department and we are actively implementing the CDC's interim guidelines for homeless shelters into our daily routine.

Supporting 10 families (including 29 children who are all of a sudden here all day every day) through this difficult time means meeting a host of emerging needs as this is a new situation for everyone.
